Requirements for Article Submission

- All articles submitted should have minimal conflict or overlap with articles submitted to professional journals based on the same research. Any applicant submitting an article that has already been published elsewhere must approve their submission with that publication.
- All submitted papers must be based on original work done by the author while registered as an undergraduate at Wesley College.
- The student's mentor or supervisor must approve the submission. The advisor's valid e-mail and phone number must be included with the application, and will be authenticated before the submission is reviewed.
- The article should be geared towards an interdisciplinary audience, and all technical terms should either be defined or explained within the context of the article.
- Figures, pictures, and drawings can be used and should be submitted with the article by attaching it electronically.

Article Format

- The article you submit should be well organized and informative.
- You should provide the appropriate amount of background information to assure that the reader can understand your research and the context in which you present it.
- The article should be well structured, with a clear introduction, main body, and conclusion.
- When writing the article, make sure that you remember you're writing it for an academic journal, not a specialized journal specific to a field. Your article should serve the following purposes:
 - a) Inform the reader about WHY you did your research - other literature on the subject, other similar/dissimilar ideas, how it relates to other topics, etc.
 - b) WHAT you did - explain your experiments, readings, etc - the article should thoroughly explain the research project/paper.
 - c) Your CONTRIBUTION, CONCLUSIONS, THOUGHTS - whether you discovered a new gene, explained how an enzyme functions, or analyzed a post-modern play - write about your discoveries, your thoughts, your conclusions!

References

This is very important: Any literature that you cited must be referenced at the end of the article. Please use A.P.A. format.

Submissions for publication must be emailed to scholarsday@wesley.edu by August 26, 2015. All submissions must include page and line numbers. Please submit all figures and tables as separate files.
