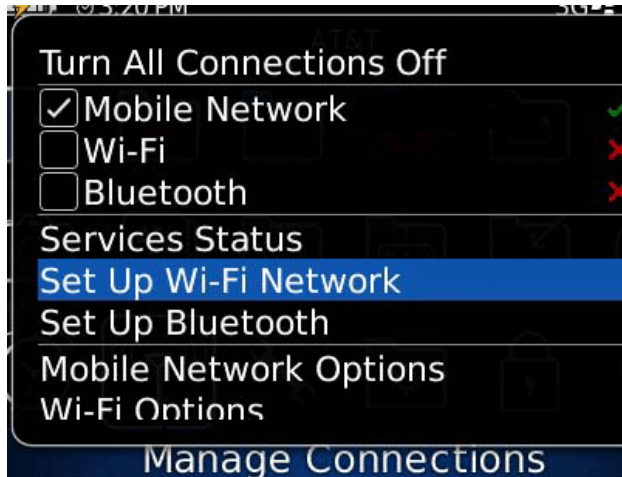


BlackBerry OS: WPA2 Configuration

Setup & Configure Wi-Fi Connection.

1. Go to Manage Connections, and select **Set Up**

Wi-Fi Network:



2. Select **Scan For Networks**. If prompted, select **Turn Wi-Fi on**.

3. Once the scan is complete, select **Wesley_Student** from the list of available networks.

4. Enter the following information in the Wi-Fi Security menu:

- Security Type: **PEAP**
- User name: **<your Wesley Username>**
ex: "john.smith"
- User password: **<your Wesley password>**
first name initial, last name initial,
student ID #, ex: "js1234567"
- CA certificate: **None Selected**
- Inner link Security: **EAP-MS-CHAP v2**
- Token: **None Selected**
- Server subject: **<leave blank>**
- Server SAN: **<leave blank>**
- Disable Server Certificate Validation:
Checked

5. Click **Connect**.

6. If prompted, select **Yes** to **Save this Wi-Fi Network as a Profile**.

Note: The BlackBerry can connect to Wesley without saving the connection as a profile. However, each subsequent connection will require you to complete process again.

7. For the **Profile Name**, enter or leave it as **Wesley_Student**.
8. Click **Next**.
9. Click **Finish** to complete the connection.

You should now be connected to the "Wesley_Student" wireless network. If you are still unable to connect after following the above instructions, contact Information Systems.
