Here are your next steps to getting started at Wesley College!

STEP 1

Submit your AP and SAT scores, final transcripts, and health information.

Scores and transcripts will be sent to the Admissions Office. Health information should be submitted to the [Wellness Center](#). Call (302) 736-2521 for health information assistance.

STEP 2

If you plan to apply for financial aid, **complete** the steps.

STEP 3

Submit your Academic Interest Inventory: [MyWesley](#).

STEP 4

Sign up for and attend a SOAR: [SOAR Registration Link](#).

SOAR is the one-day Summer Orientation Program. You will learn what it means to live on-campus, how to succeed academically, and access your Fall schedule of classes.

STEP 5

Sign-up for housing and submit any roommate requests.
